Motion: Amend Bylaws Motion 16, Article IV, Section , Term of office by adding wording

CURRENT WORDING	PROPOSED WORDING
<p>Section 5 – Term of office</p> <p>A. Board members shall be elected to serve for a period of one (1) year, with the exception of the treasurer, RR(s) and the WSO conference delegates, who may be elected for a two (2) year term. Newly elected officers shall begin service at the PI meeting following their election.</p> <p>B. Board members may be elected to a second one (1) year term in the same office.</p> <p>C. Board members elected to partial terms may be elected to the next full term in the same office.</p> <p>D. After serving two (2) years.in the same position, a member may be elected to a different position. Board members shall not serve more than four (4) consecutive years.</p> <p>E. After serving four (4) years, a member must be off the board for one (1) year before being eligible to run for a board position.</p> <p>F. Upon election to the Board, members shall cease to be a representative of their group, and that group shall elect a new IR.</p>	<p>Section 5 – Term of office</p> <p>A.
